2) What should you be doing?

• What is the Point Person's function? (excerpt from the Glossary ©)

-Point Person: The person(s) from a church or ministry who will be the *JLK* <u>COMMUNICATON LINK</u> and <u>MOBILIZER</u> for their organization. We encourage pastors to choose someone other than themselves to fill this role. The Point Person should be a mature believer, organized, responsible and enthusiastic about encouraging others to engage with *Jesus Loves Kzoo*.

- If possible, form a "Point Team" and work together
- If possible, get your lead pastor and church staff on board and in the know (without involving them in the smaller details)
- Where to find resources?

- How will we be communicating with you?
 - **o** BY EMAIL: Weekly Point Person emails beginning in April with tips and prayer points.
 - Two specified "Progress Check-in" dates (April 18 and June 15)
 - Point Person Meetings in May and June

- How and when should you be registering volunteers?
 - Catalyst Week Registration is already open (link on web site)
 - You can also use a paper form to sign people up (make your own or use one we will have available on resource page).
 - <u>Right now</u>, focus on getting leaders on board and getting the general word out as a "save the date" for Catalyst Week. Most churches push registrations mid-May to late-June
- How and when should you be getting your volunteers "Red-shirted-up"?
 - Will be discussed in detail at the May meeting
 - Bulk order deadline for churches will be June 20.
- How should our church contribute to Catalyst Week supply needs?
 - Some churches contribute financially, others collect supplies, others do both. Pray and ask God what is "in your hand"?
 - CARE PACKAGE new collection method with churches choosing certain items to focus on (sign-up genius.com)
 - FOOD AND SUPPLIES new sign up method (sign-up genius.com).
 - All registered volunteers will get this link.
 - Please set up a collection point at your church and deliver on June 26
