- Serving as a 'bridge', connecting churches and individuals together with similar passions and callings for impacting the community



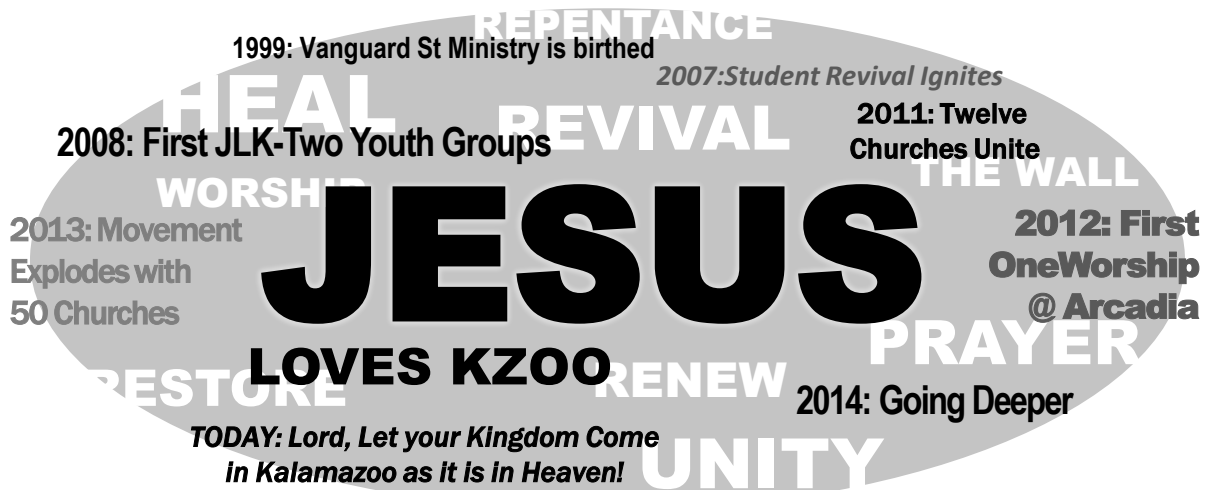
Connect individuals reached through the ministry to resources & discipleship...

The History of Jesus Loves Kzoo

In 2008, *Jesus Loves Kzoo* (JLK) started out as a small Vanguard Street Ministry outreach event to the north side of Kalamazoo with student volunteers from two local churches. Over the past eight years, Jesus Loves Kzoo has grown to become not only an event but a 'movement' that has unified the Body of Christ to do the Great Commission together, sharing the love of Jesus throughout the Kalamazoo Region.

As JLK has recently grown in size and scope, the leadership is currently in the process of obtaining 501c3 status under the name "Jesus Loves" so that the movement's core elements might be easily multiplied in other cities and regions.



Faith Statement
