
Cultivate Unity among Christ-following churches and ministries...

The History of Jesus Loves Kzoo

Jesus Loves Kzoo (JLK) started out in 2008 as a small Vanguard Street Ministry outreach event to the north side of Kalamazoo with student volunteers from two local churches. Since that time, Jesus Loves Kzoo has grown to become not only an event but a 'movement' that has ignited and unified the Body of Christ to do the Great Commission together, sharing the love of Jesus throughout the Kalamazoo Region.

In 2016, JLK obtained 501c3 status under the name "Jesus Loves" so that the movement's core elements might be easily multiplied in other cities and regions. Today, *Jesus Loves* continues to press forward, equipping and empowering churches to join forces in leading people to Christ by sharing the Gospel in both word and deed.

Faith Statement

We believe in one God, Creator of the heavens and the earth, infinitely perfect and eternal existing in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

The perfection with which God created everything was subjected to a curse through the disobedience of humankind and, as a result, a separation between God and creation was formed. With this separation came sin, sickness, disease, and death all of which were foreign to the perfection with which God created everything.

Jesus Christ is the solution to this problem. Being fully God and fully human, he was born, died on the cross, rose from the dead, ascended into heaven and lives forever as the mediator between God and humankind. Through faith in Jesus alone, the Holy Spirit can now indwell all who believe and provide the salvation Jesus paid for.

We believe that the Bible is the Holy Spirit inspired Word of God and the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of humankind. It has divine authority for all Christian life and faith.

We believe in the personal imminent return of Jesus Christ and that, until that return happens, his body (the community of believers) is to work diligently to spread the good news and work to see God's Kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven.



JLK Catalyst Week July 10-15, 2022

If Jesus Loves Kzoo is a movement, not an event... what is the big deal about this one week in July?

As we move toward a Kingdom vision of community revival, we believe it is vitally important for there to be at least <u>one core event each year</u> that is truly a "trumpet call" for the Church (Neh. 4:19-20).

Catalyst Week has become this core event.

When the trumpet sounds and the whole Body comes together under the banner of Jesus Christ, praying, loving and serving in a very visible way, God promises to use the Oneness of His bride to bring people to the saving knowledge of His Son (John 17:22-23).

A catalyst is defined as an agent that "provokes or speeds significant change or action". As we DO the Great Commission together, (past denominational, ethnic and socioeconomic lines), we believe God will use the obedience of the Church as a **CATALYST**, igniting something bigger than ourselves, paving the way for revival.

Communication


Every church needs a great Point Person (or Point Team). The Point Person is the central communication link and means to mobilize the individual churches.


FORCE MULTIPLY


